## Presidio Soccer League & San Diego Development Academy Referee Responsibilities Check List (short form)

Presidio has made the process easier for you to report your games online, this now includes the **Red Card Supplemental Report**. The **Red Card Supplemental Report** will now be reported in the Comments Section titled "Supplemental Incident Report / Game Comments". This is a PRIVATE area and only Presidio League Administrators can see what has been written by you or the managers. Referee Assault will still need a written USSF Supplemental Report.

Our Presidio League Directors still require a copy of ALL game reports be sent to the <u>Director listed on the game roster</u>. <u>WITHIN 24 HOURS</u>, the center referee must enter their report online or review and acknowledge the game stats if already entered by the teams by clicking on "<u>SAVE STATS & COMMENTS</u>".

We have are entire rules available as a download from our website. We recommend that you read this in its entirety and retain a copy for your reference.

Below is a guide to what is expected if you accept to do a game in Presidio or SDDA:

## **Pre-Game**

- 1. Referees must be registered with Cal South, be shown on the approved list, and know Presidio and SDDA League rules.
- 2. Must have current year Cal South Referee ID Card at game, and show it to both teams administrators before the game.
- 3. Referees <u>must conduct a proper check in</u> of the teams by matching Official Match/Game Roster to laminated Player ID Cards or if team forgets cards, match pictures on roster to players. Player without a picture on the roster or a laminated Cal South Player card cannot play.
- 4. By design there is only 15 minutes between games. It is recommended that you start your check in for the next game <u>immediately at the end of the game that just finished, don't wait</u>. ARs should start with the Home Team First and then the Visiting Team, while Center referee does the game report.
- 5. To keep games on time, League Rules state that <u>players must be in their game jersey 15 minutes prior to</u> <u>the posted start time.</u> Please enter on the Match/Game Roster and in the online Comments any team(s) not ready to be checked in. The league will discuss this issue with the team(s) so this doesn't happen again.
- 6. Match/Game Roster must have jersey numbers and be signed by coaches or manager **before game**.
- 7. Coach must have a Cal South Coaching Card and a coach must be there for the **entire game**.
- 8. Complete any Cash on the Field paperwork, when required.

## **After Game**

- 1. Each referee must PRINT their name on the Match/Game Roster so it can be read.
- 2. Center referee must report the game online within 24 hours, no excuses.
- 3. Go to www.presidiosoccer.com click on Login & Info then click Presidio Login or SDDA Login. Use your Cal South Username and Password to sign in and click the link 2015 Presidio / SDDA Scoring.
- 4. Not sure how to do report your game, watch the video at Referee Score Your Game link.
- 5. Enter all Yellow Cards and select the appropriate reason from the dropdown. See list on left column.
- 6. Enter all Red Cards and <u>complete a report for each Red card in the "Supplemental Incident Report / Game Comments"</u> section of the Game Stats Entry Screen. **This is your SUPPLEMENTAL REPORT.**
- 7. Complete the Match Review pop up. New this year.
- 8. Remember to click on "SAVE STATS & COMMENTS" before leaving page. Now you are done.
- 9. Remember **Referee Assault will require both** a USSF Supplemental Report and a report in the "Supplemental Incident Report / Game Comments" section of the Game Stats Entry Screen.
- 10. <u>Finally, DON'T FORGET</u> Send all Match/Game Rosters to the director listed on the Match/Game Roster. They can be sent by any media photo, fax, scan, pdf, or regular mail.
