

PRESIDIO SOCCER LEAGUE ONLINE APPLICATION – June 1, 2019 to May 31, 2020.

- 1. This year all leagues must complete their Presidio League Application and Requirements online. The requested information can be entered by any board member but acceptance of the ELAs must be done by the League's President in order for the application to be considered by Presidio Soccer League.**
- 2. If you have teams playing in San Diego Developmental Academy (SDDA) you will need to complete the SDDA League Application and Requirements also. Again the ELAs must be done by the League's President in order for the application to be considered by Presidio Soccer League.**
- 3. All submitted applications will be reviewed and verified by Presidio's Board for presentation to member leagues for approval at the General Membership meeting in April.**

By completing this application, the league consents to abide by the following:

- The Bylaws, Rules and Regulations of Presidio Soccer League, Cal South, United States Youth Soccer Association (USYSA) and the United States Soccer Federation (USSF), and all directives of the governing boards of these bodies.
- All League Program Administrators as defined per Rule 6.3.1.2.1 (i.e. Board Members, Coaches, Volunteers and anyone acting in an official capacity on behalf of the league) will complete the Cal South Kidsafe Risk Management requirements.
- Register all players with Cal South and pay player registration fees as set forth by the Cal South Board of Directors (Rule 1.3.2.2).
- Comply with all CORIS activation rules.
- Will not utilize any personal registration information garnered through Presidio Soccer League affiliation to directly promote the interests of outside competing entities.
- Ensure that all administrators and players participating in all games scheduled or hosted by said league will use Cal South / US Youth Soccer player & administrator cards for all competition.
- Provide procedures and a committee for the prompt and equitable resolution of protest, appeals, and discipline of members.
- Have a Primary League Registrar that has been certified in accordance with the mandatory Cal South League Registrar Certification program required for CORIS access.
- Ensure that all League Board Members, Coaches, Team Administrators, Parents and Players act in a respectful manner at all times when discussing and/or resolving issues pertaining to Presidio Soccer League. Failure to comply with any of the included terms may be subject, but not limited to the following:
 - Denial or revocation of Presidio Soccer League Gaming Privileges.
 - Suspension from any and all Presidio Soccer League Games and/or Events.
 - Monetary Fines.

We understand that in accordance with this application, that the Presidio Soccer League Bylaws, Rules and Regulations, League Policies and overall compliance thereof is required for the purpose of good standing membership in Presidio Soccer League. Membership in Presidio Soccer League is by privilege, not by right.

We further agree and authorize Cal South, its related business partners and any Referee Association we contract with to share any financially related information and member contact information upon request.

We further agree that all books and records of the league shall be open to inspection upon the written/email request of Presidio Soccer League or its agent at any reasonable time.

- All prior Financial Obligation due Presidio Soccer League, Cal South, Referee Associations, Referees or Paid Staff are to be paid in full.
- Current & Completed league VIP Directory submitted online and verified by Presidio Soccer League
- All League Contacts, Coaches and Team Administrator e-mail addresses and phone numbers are updated and maintained on the CORIS and Presidio Online systems throughout the season
- That you understand and are familiar with Presidio Soccer League Rules and Regulations
- Submit proof of sufficient fields and copies of detailed field permits upon requests that include permitted usage dates and times, field addresses and directions along with field governing entity contact information
- Use only Referee Associations that have been approved by Presidio Soccer League
- Submit completed and signed Referee Association Contract or Agreement for upcoming seasonal year along with their contact information
- New Leagues filing an application for Presidio Soccer League Membership consideration, must submit documentation regarding but not limited to financial viability, minimum number of players/teams, field availability, current member impact, licensed coaching staff, referee association agreements, executive board and DOC experience.

New League Only

- Submit organization governance bylaws
- Submit current financial statement and pro-forma annual cash flow budget
- Submit a listing of all other leagues within 10 miles, the reason you wish to start a new league, and why you are not seeking membership in a currently existing league
- Submit resumes on Executive Board Members and Director of Coaching
- Submit list of committed coaching staff and their USSF coaching license level
- Submit analysis statement regarding the number of teams, gender and ages of players committed to play in your prospective league – include copies of all player registration forms
- Submit analysis statement regarding prospective player's registration status, ie. Percentage of your players that were registered last year with Cal South

* Each league bears the responsibility of keeping all requirements on file current with Presidio Soccer League.
