

SAN DIEGO DEVELOPEMENTAL ACADEMY (SDDA) LEAGUE ONLINE REGISTRATION

- 1. If you have teams playing in San Diego Developmental Academy (SDDA) you will need to complete the SDDA League Application and Requirements. Again the ELAs must be done by the League's President in order for the application to be considered by Presidio Soccer League/SDDA.**
- 2. All submitted applications will be reviewed and verified by Presidio's Board for presentation to member leagues for approval at the General Membership meeting in April.**

By completing this application, the league consents to abide by the following:

- All San Diego Developmental Academy must be registered and approved as a League in Presidio Soccer League.
- Leagues must follow the Bylaws, Rules and Regulations of Presidio Soccer League unless otherwise defined in the Rules and Regulations of the San Diego Developmental League.

Failure to comply with any of the included terms may be subject, but not limited to the following:

- Denial or revocation of San Diego Developmental Academy Gaming Privileges.
- Suspension from any and all San Diego Developmental Academy Games and/or Events.
- Monetary Fines.
- We understand that in accordance with this application, that the Presidio Soccer League Bylaws, Rules and Regulations, League Policies and overall compliance thereof is required for the purpose of good standing membership in the San Diego Developmental Academy. Membership in San Diego Developmental Academy is by privilege, not by right.
- Acceptance of Leagues and Teams are subject to approval by the Membership of the San Diego Developmental Academy using the following criteria:
- \$2,000 Initial League Membership Fee.
- Functioning Board of Directors with minimum one-year meeting minutes (minimum quarterly meetings).
- Minimum 80% attendance at San Diego Developmental Academy committee meetings.
- Director of Coaching or Technical Director must attend and participate in Showcases and Festivals as determined by the San Diego Developmental Academy committee.
- Director of Coaching or Technical Director with a national level license, minimum "C" or "National Youth", NSCAA National Diploma or UEFA "B". In the event applicant club does not meet this requirement at the time of application, a grace period (to be determined by the executive committee) may be granted for "Provisional Membership" status until requirement has been met.
- Club must have a minimum of 10 registered teams in good standing with Presidio Soccer League and Cal South.
- Club must have sufficient permitted fields meeting the minimum San Diego Developmental Academy standards.
- Club must have a functioning coaching curriculum, guiding the clubs' player development.
- Club must commit and abide to the SDDA Code of Ethics and Rules & Regulations.

Appeals to decisions made by the SDDA only requires approval from the Presidio Board of Directors, not by Presidio's general membership. In addition, the SDDA directly accountable to the Presidio President.

Presidio Soccer League, SDDA and New League – Check-Lists

- Cal South League Application form completed or in process to become a current Cal South Member
- Complete Presidio Soccer League Application Online
- Payment of Presidio Soccer League Application fee
- All prior Financial Obligation due Presidio Soccer League, Cal South, Referee Associations, Referees or Paid Staff are to be paid in full.
- Current & Completed league VIP Directory submitted online and verified by Presidio Soccer League
- All League Contacts, Coaches and Team Administrator e-mail addresses and phone numbers are updated and maintained on the CORIS and Presidio Online systems throughout the season
- That you understand and are familiar with Presidio Soccer League Rules and Regulations
- Submit proof of sufficient fields and copies of detailed field permits upon requests that include permitted usage dates and times, field addresses and directions along with field governing entity contact information
- Use only Referee Associations that have been approved by Presidio Soccer League
- Submit completed and signed Referee Association Contract or Agreement for upcoming seasonal year along with their contact information
- New Leagues filing an application for Presidio Soccer League Membership consideration, must submit documentation regarding but not limited to financial viability, minimum number of players/teams, field availability, current member impact, licensed coaching staff, referee association agreements, executive board and DOC experience.

New League Only

- Submit organization governance bylaws
- Submit current financial statement and pro-forma annual cash flow budget
- Submit a listing of all other leagues within 10 miles, the reason you wish to start a new league, and why you are not seeking membership in a currently existing league
- Submit resumes on Executive Board Members and Director of Coaching
- Submit list of committed coaching staff and their USSF coaching license level
- Submit analysis statement regarding the number of teams, gender and ages of players committed to play in your prospective league – include copies of all player registration forms
- Submit analysis statement regarding prospective player's registration status, ie. Percentage of your players that were registered last year with Cal South

* Each league bears the responsibility of keeping all requirements on file current with Presidio Soccer League.
